Prayer

1. Annette Arthur, the Secretary of Keiraview Uniting Church Council, emailed the following information about a church initiative for our prayer support.

Our property adjoins the Wollongong West Public School. While seeking to connect with our local community and talking with school executive, it was discovered that there were no male teachers on staff and many pupils had no strong male role models. For the past twelve months men from our congregation have attended the school each Monday to interact with the children, particularly boys, while playing games, engaging in computer coding and assisting class teachers with various classroom activities. More recently this interaction has extended to involve a female mentor and girl students.

We ask for prayer for this programme that the children will respond well to the mentors and that positive outcomes for improved behaviour will result.

2. Pray for the many Christmas Carol Services being held over the next few weeks. This is a great opportunity to invite friends and neighbours along to hear the gospel proclaimed.

- 2. The Faith for Life seminar last Friday presented by Bible Society and HammondCare explained how the new resources could be used with people suffering from dementia. It was emphasised that Christians declining with dementia are still Christians with the Holy Spirit even though their brains were not functioning properly. Also, those who are not Christians can be reached with the love of God. The "Faith for Life" resources are available on-line for carers and nursing home workers at Koorong or HammondCare.
