St Peter & St Paul Coptic Orthodox Church is located at 41 Kelly St, Berkeley. The senior minister is Fr Moses Ayad. Services are held in English on Sundays at 8:30 a.m. and in Arabic fortnightly on Saturdays at 8:30 a.m. The term Coptic means Egyptian, so the church is the Egyptian expression of Orthodox Christianity. The church invites people to come and see how the earliest church worships.

- 1. Catholic Clergy appointments: Fr Damien Ellis is now Parish Priest at St Michael's Nowra, Fr Paul Clark is Parish Priest of Helensburgh Parish, Fr Joseph Pothenparampil is Chaplain at Wollongong Public and Private Hospitals, and Fr Mark De Battista is Parish Priest to St Mary's Berkeley, St Francis Warrawong while continuing as Parish Priest at St Patrick's Port Kembla.
- 2. The documentary, **The First Hymn**, has been released and is presently showing at **Hoyts**, **Warrawong**. The documentary relates the story of the discovery of a fragment of papyrus in 1918 in Egypt. John Dickson was intrigued by the few lines of a hymn, complete with musical notation, dated to the third century which proclaimed a trinitarian faith a hundred years before the Council of Nicaea (325 C.E.). John Dickson asked his friends Ben Fielding, from Australia, and Tomlinson for USA to write a modern worship song based on The First Hymn.
