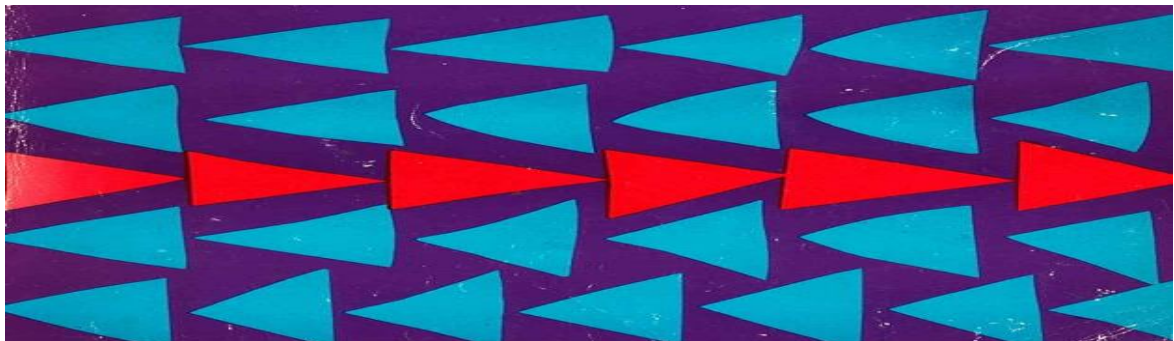


Jesus goes up to Jerusalem.
